Dear Parents and Carers ,

A very warm welcome back to Seaton school, on the first day of the autumn term. We were delighted to see everyone today bright eyed and bushy tailed and all of the staff are looking forward to the term ahead.

The first day is complete and we are pleased with how the children have settled back into class.

Here are a few reminders and things to consider when dropping off or collecting your child.

1. Please stick to your allotted times.

- We need **A LOT MORE** of you using the **large, rear metal bottom gate** to enter / depart from (**near Pink Hippos**). Please, if you normally come in that way continue to use it still or **vary your journey**. Remember to follow the one way system around the daily mile track.
- If you come in via the front entrance but want to **depart via the bottom gate** of the field then that is fine.
- Avoid blocking the pavements**. Stand to one side.
- Picking up – **Space out** on the rear playground if you are collecting from there or the car park / entrance.
- Pupils in years 3, 4, 5 and 6** will be building their confidence very quickly and won't need escorting onto site once they are familiar with where their new classroom is.
- Please can we ask if you are picking up your child from Year 5/6 that you **wait in the car park and not** outside the 5/6 area by Happy Hawks.

I have had a few questions about COVID testing and just to let you know we won't be undertaking any testing without your full consent and consultation.

These remain quite tricky times but with your co-operation, we feel confident moving forward. It is not to say that things won't change because inevitably they will.

Additional outside hand washing facilities have been installed around the school, we would like to say a huge thank you to the PTA for providing these facilities.
